In this activity the students learnt how they are different from each other, and the teacher conducted a palm print activity so they gave their palm prints . This activity helps them to develop their fine motor skills.



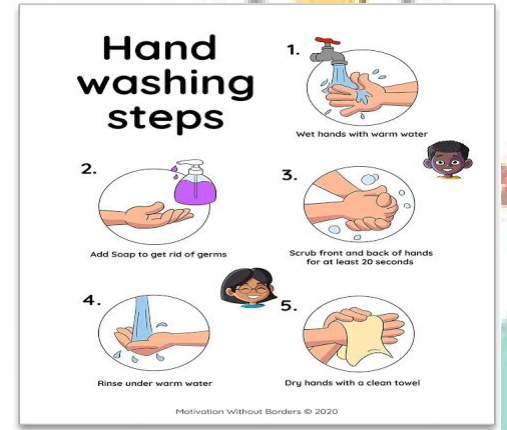
# MONDAY

Children can now orally recall and revise numbers from 1 to 30.

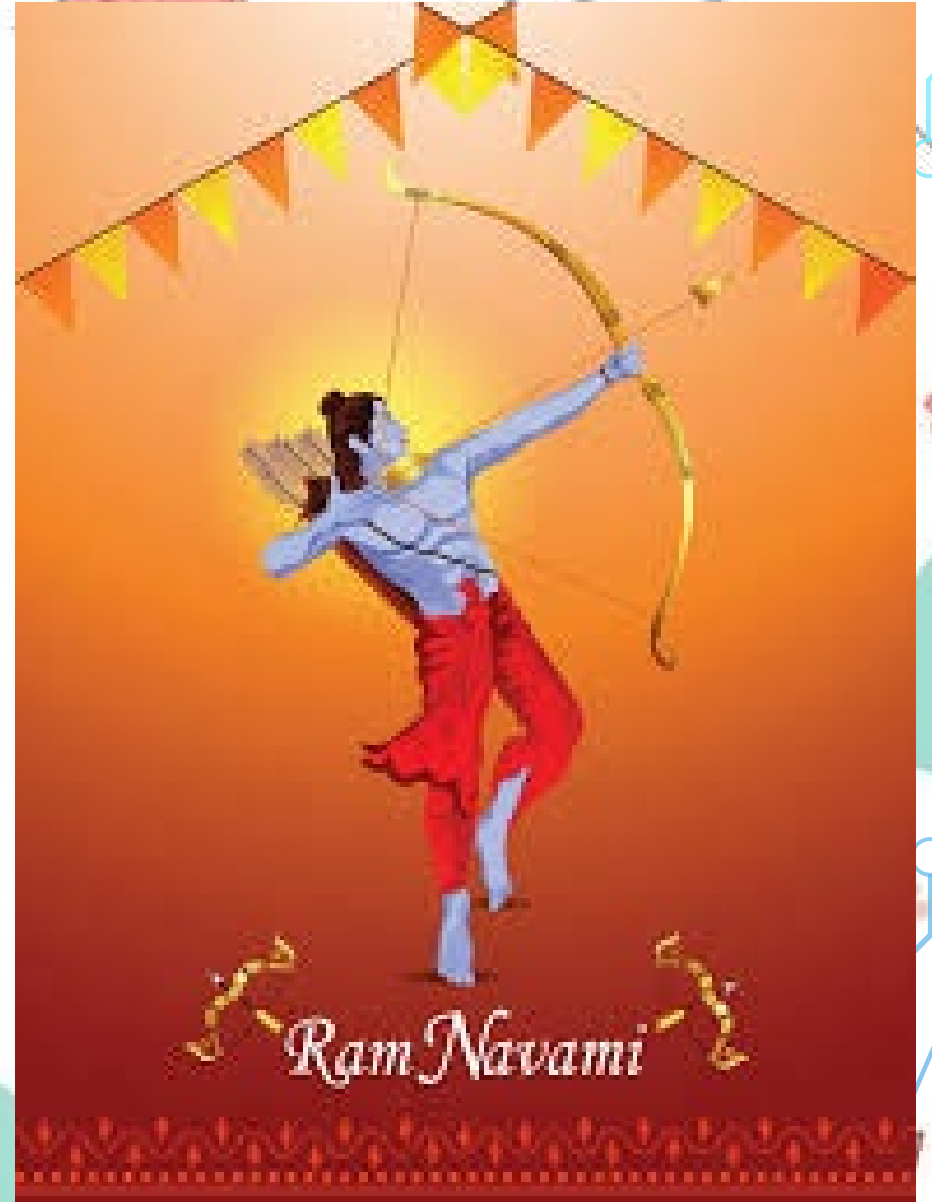
Students have learned the names of body parts and can now confidently identify them all.
